To promote agricultural education in the state, the South Carolina Fertilizer and Agrichemicals Association (SCFAA) presents two scholarships annually to worthy Clemson University students in crop and soil environmental science, horticulture, or biosystems engineering.

Rachel Macauley Vanblaricom of Clemson, SC, a senior in Biosystems Engineering, was awarded the A.B. Everett Scholarship, and Michael Wall of Easley, SC, a junior in Biosystems Engineering, received the Gilbert H. Collings Scholarship. Each recipient was selected by the Clemson University Scholarships and Awards Committee on behalf of the SCFAA.

The SCFAA was formed in 1988 with the merger of the Pesticide Association of South Carolina and the South Carolina Plant Food Educational Society.

SCFAA members include fertilizer, chemical, and seed company representatives and others involved in the production, processing, and marketing of crop production products. Members of the SCFAA work closely with regulatory officials and legislators to make sure that the products they produce, process, and sell to farmers meet or exceed the highest quality standards possible.

Commissioner's Column

Equestrians Receive Conservation Award

For the 5th consecutive year, BMW and the Palmetto Conservation Foundation have joined forces to present the BMW Conservation Award. The award is presented to individuals who have made lifetime contributions to protecting South Carolina's natural and cultural resources. The recipients for the 2002 BMW Conservation Award,

Dale and Judy Thiel of Camden, are as involved in their conservation efforts as they are in the business of agriculture.

Recognized as an industry leader in the production of environmentally sustainable vehicles, BMW Manufacturing Corp., is also deeply concerned with preservation and conservation of natural and cultural resources.

That concern goes hand in hand with the mission of the Palmetto Conservation Foundation to conserve natural and cultural resources, preserve historic buildings and landmarks, and promote outdoor recreation through trails and greenways. A statewide nonprofit organization, the Palmetto Conservation Foundation brings a research-based, non-adversarial approach to conservation, preservation and recreation in South Carolina.

The Thiels have been active in equestrian and fox hunting events in the Camden area for almost four decades. Both are masters or former masters of the state's oldest and largest foxhunt, the Camden Hunt established in 1926.

Dale moved to Camden from New York in 1954 and managed stables and rode in local steeplechase races for horse racing legend Ray Wolfe. He rode seven winners until 1957 when a horse fell on him, fracturing his femur. Dale never raced competitively again.

Dale and his wife, Judy, a native of Memphis, Tennessee, paid for their first year's rent with a horse. In 1975, Dale Thiel became the race director of the Carolina Cup and Colonial Cup races. He retired as race director after 15 years of service.

Through their Firestone-Thiel Land Foundation, the Thiels have worked quietly and methodically for more than 20 years to put together a 15-square-mile tract of woodland known as Camden Hunt Country, the site of the state's oldest and largest fox hunt. It is the state's largest privately owned preserve open to the public for equestrian and fox hunting activities. Because of the Thiels, the 12,500-acre site will be protected forever from urban development. The wooded property sandwiched by U.S. 521 on the east and U.S. 1 to the west includes creeks, wetlands and the Camden watershed which provide drinking water for the town of Camden. Today, the Camden Hunt has over 200 members who participate in the twice-weekly hunts that begin at Thanksgiving and run until mid-March.

In addition to their conservation efforts, the Thiels also own Equistar Products and own and manage Dale Thiel Stables in Camden, specializing in show horses, boarding and riding lessons.

The BMW Conservation Award will be presented to the Thiels on Friday, November 1, 2002 from 6-8 p.m. at the National Steeplechase Museum. Tickets are \$40 per person and proceeds benefit the Palmetto Conservation Foundation.

I congratulate Dale and Judy on their accomplishments and for their lifetime conservation efforts. Balancing construction and conservation is an on-going process in which we must all participate. While land is a valuable commodity for urban and industrial expansion and development, it is equally important for its agricultural, natural, and cultural resources. We must have a balance of both for continued progress in South Carolina.
