

Symposium on Conservation Easements

Landowners, real estate developers, environmentalists, and concerned citizens are invited to attend the symposium, "Conservation Easements—The Voluntary Protection of Land," on November 14, 2000, at the Palmetto Expo Center in Greenville, SC. The all day conference, sponsored by Upstate Forever and the Foothills Resource Conservation and Development (RC&D) Council, will be devoted entirely to explaining, discussing, and analyzing conservation easements. The registration fee is \$20 on or before November 3, 2000, and \$25 for late registration. This fee includes lunch.

Conservation easements are one of the most popular and widely used means of protecting natural, scenic, agricultural, and historic lands in the United States. It involves a voluntary agreement by the landowner to give up some or all of the rights to develop property, for which the owner can realize significant income, estate, and property tax benefits.

Experts in the field will explain the standard provisions in easements, their tax benefits and how they are appraised, and property owners who have conservation easements will also be available to answer questions. This is the first in-depth conference on conservation easements that has ever been held in the Upstate.

A portion of the proceeds from the sale of all the calendars will be retained by the participating FFA chapters to further their local educational programs. The cooperative effort increases awareness of agriculture in the state, and, at the same time, supports high school and college students preparing for careers in the science, business, or technology of agriculture and related areas.

SC Cattlemen's Association Celebrates 50 Years

An electric power plant will be constructed on the Savannah River above Augusta. Kudzu is being used for grazing livestock and for land erosion. Flue-cured tobacco is grown in 31 counties in the state. There are 427,000 cows and calves, 165,000 milk cows, and 612,000 hogs in South Carolina. The Columbia State Farmers Market on Bluff Road in Columbia will be opening soon. John Trask & Sons of Beaufort are installing the first farm radio system in their trucks and cars. Gramling Peach Shed near Spartanburg is trying an experimental little machine which defuzzes peaches. And, the SC Cattlemen's Association is being organized. *That was in 1950!*

Times have changed. Producers and farmers are still looking for new ways to improve their operations. And, for 50 years, the South Carolina Cattlemen's Association has been working to assist producers--producers who care about keeping the family farm and a stable economy, protecting the environment, providing a safe food supply, and about the welfare of their animals. And, we all should care that they are doing their best for us.

Times are good for most people in this nation. It's during times like these when things are good and we have enough of everything that we often neglect to think of the possibility that our children or our children's children may not have enough of anything, if farmers stop farming.

This year on November 2-3, the South Carolina Cattlemen's Association will celebrate their 50th anniversary at their Annual Conference and Trade Show in Greenville at Embassy Suites. The agenda for the conference includes several industry speakers as well as Congressman Jim DeMint of Greenville and me. I am deeply honored to be invited to take part in their event.

In addition to speakers, the association, under the guidance of their new executive director, Brian Bolt, has planned a series of educational sessions on Thursday, November 2nd in the Cattlemen's College sponsored by Pfizer Animal Health. The program on Friday will highlight several industry-related topics as well as a banquet that evening focusing on the history of the association.

The South Carolina Cattlemen's Association is owned, controlled, managed, and funded by and for producers of all breeds of cattle. There are over 25 county or multi-county local associations functioning around the state, and the SCCA is, in turn, a charter affiliate member of the National Cattlemen's Beef Association.

The association of over 2,200 cattle men and women unites producers to advance the economic, political, and social interests of the state's cattle industry. Workshops, seminars, and meetings, like the one to be held in Greenville, are designed to help cattlemen stay abreast of new technology, production techniques, risk management, and other areas related to cattle.

The South Carolina Cattlemen's Association is also helping to ensure agriculture's future by supporting the South Carolina FFA through the sale of the 2001 Art and Agriculture Watercolor Collection calendars. The front cover of the calendar depicts Neil Boyd's Charolais cows in a pasture in Clover, SC. Another is of Angus cows, painted by Barbara Yon of Ridge Spring who has a vested interest in the cattle business. Her son, Kevin, and his wife, Lydia "McGill" Yon, are cattle producers from long-time cattle farm families. You could almost call the 2001 calendar a real "cow-lender."

Times have changed, indeed! We now have nuclear-powered as well as hydro-electric plants. Kudzu is an unwanted weed. Livestock numbers are down from the 50s, while quality is up. Farm radios have been replaced by cell phones. But, one thing hasn't changed--the care and concern that our producers give to their cattle and calves. In fact, the SC Cattlemen's Association is working harder than ever to help their members produce the best quality products possible for you and your family.
