Savannah River Site

The Department of Energy notified us today that SRS personnel have begun efforts that will result in the processing and permanent disposal of six metric tons of surplus non-pit plutonium (this process is the process you discussed with Sec. Moniz earlier this year). SRS will down-blend the material, diluting the plutonium to a more secure mixture. It will be stored at the SRS Solid Waste Management facility and placed in the appropriate queue of material that will ultimately be disposed of at the WIPP facility in New Mexico (WIPP is still not operational). **This project does not involve plutonium originally intended for disposition through the MOX facility.**

Disaster Recovery, CDBG-DR

While we are still awaiting final approval from HUD for our disaster recover state plan, Commerce has hired Horne as the vendor to implement the plan upon approval. Horne is the same company that wrote the Action Plan.
