

October 1, 1943.

The Budget Commission met in the Governor's Office at 11:30 o'clock on October 1, 1943. All members of the Commission were present.

The Commission approved an allocation of \$1350.00 from the 1943-44 Civil Contingent Fund for the employment of a Steno-Clerk in the Department of Education, School Lunch Program, for the remainder of the fiscal year, nine months.

The Secretary was instructed to request Hon. James H. Hammond to refund the unused balance of funds supplied to the War Finance Committee, same amounting to \$3,557.42.

The Secretary was instructed to request that the Speaker of the House appoint three from the membership of the House to act with the Special Senate Committee on State Employees.

The Commission fixed the dates of October 12 and 13 to visit the State Colored College, the State Medical College, and The Citadel; and asked that the Secretary invite the Lieutenant-Governor and the Speaker of the House of Representatives to attend budget hearings this Fall.

Dr. C. Fred Williams, Superintendent of the State Hospital, appeared before the Commission to discuss the question of inaugurating an eight hour day for nurses and other employees of the State Hospital. He stated that this would be necessary to comply with Federal requirements if the State Hospital is to qualify as a Standard Training School for Nurses. The Commission advised him not to undertake this change at the present time, since it would be necessary to increase the appropriation for the State Hospital by a considerable amount if the plan were adopted.

The Commission then adjourned.
