



Music Icon Quincy Jones



Named by Time Magazine as one of the most influential jazz musicians of the 20th century, Quincy Jones has received 27 Grammy Awards and 79 nominations.

He produced the arrangement “Fly Me to the Moon” and Michael Jackson’s multi-platinum albums “Off the Wall,” “Bad,” and “Thriller.” From “Roots” to “The Color Purple,”

his work has garnered an Emmy Award and 7 Oscar nominations.

Quincy is equally famous for giving back. In 2010, he co-produced a new version of his iconic “We Are the World” to raise funds for Haiti relief.

Supermodel Beverly Johnson

Beverly Johnson is the first African-American supermodel. Her stunning features and superstardom landed her on the cover of Vogue magazine in 1974, making world history as the first black model to grace the cover and forever changing the beauty ideal in the fashion world.

Beverly’s remarkable career, which spans three decades, is a showcase of accomplishment: from model to mom then actress, author, activist, businesswoman, TV personality, and — finally — icon. Beverly appeared on more than 500 magazine covers. Her success during the ‘70s and ‘80s transcended race as Beverly became a household name. Beverly worked the runway for such designers as Yves St. Laurent, Valentino, Calvin Klein, Ralph Lauren and Halston.







Since then, I have overcome several heart surgeries, and despite a lack of speech, I am thriving. I have played soccer and “attended more baseball games than most of us will in our lifetime,” my mom said. I’m an expert at movies and love music and dancing. My parents, Jeff and Deedra, praise my strong work ethic at our country home in Glen Rose, Texas.


In addition to my twin, I have two older siblings, David and Matthew. “They’ve formed a fierce band of brothers that will battle if anyone ever crosses their brave little brother,” my mom said.
