Two hundred thirty one years ago, early in the morning of August 10, a significant Revolutionary War Battle took place along a timbered ridge a half-mile north of the Enoree River. Join us as we commemorate the battle and honor those who fought and those who died at Musgrove Mill.

A ceremony will be held at 10 AM by local, state and regional chapters of the Daughters of the American Revolution and Sons of the American Revolution to honor battle participants. There will be talks and demonstrations by noted speakers, authors and historians throughout the day. Park grounds will be open from 9 am to 6 pm.
