We are writing to invite you to participate in an exciting community event taking place in the upstate. On May 9, 2015, local sponsors will join with Spartanburg District One Schools to host the Second Annual "Color Us One" 5k Color Run. This event will celebrate a year focused on health and wellness led by the schools in District One. We sincerely hope you will support us in this event.

The theme of the run this year is "One Community, One in Fitness, One in Fun." It begins at 9 a.m. at Landrum Middle School, goes through downtown Landrum, and winds up back at the middle school stadium. In an effort to accommodate all types of individuals and encourage participation, we will also offer a 3k "Fun Run" and a "Walk for Fun."

Last year as we planned for the event, we decided to set some lofty goals. We hoped for and planned for at least 300 people to participate.
