Modernizing Withholding: change is a good thing

In January 2017, South Carolina is updating Withholding Tax tables for the first time in 25 years. This is a big change to South Carolina's Withholding process, and we want you to be ready!

Are you an employer, accountant, payroll provider, or software developer? You will need to update the Withholding tables that your payroll systems use for **January 2017**.

Are you an individual taxpayer? No action is necessary to prepare for this change. Beginning in 2017, you may notice a very small increase in your paychecks throughout the year which will result in a slightly smaller South Carolina income tax refund in 2018.

Also new in 2017, 4th Quarter Withholding Returns (Oct-Nov-Dec 2016) are due the last day of January 2017.
