lying and being in Grantville Township of the reserved lands of the Town of Painsburg  
Biding and Bounding to the South West North & East on Valiant's Land to the East and  
South on the Land of Abraham Cardwell to the South and West on Long Creek called  
New River to the South North & East on the River of May and to the West
