Company investing an additional \$15 million to create 125 new jobs

COLUMBIA, S.C. – Nutramax Laboratories and its family of companies, a leading manufacturer of nutritional supplement products for people and their pets, is expanding operations in Lancaster County. The company is investing an additional \$15 million in the project, creating 125 new jobs in Lancaster, S.C.

Since 1992, Nutramax Laboratories has been researching and developing high-quality nutritional supplement products for people and their pets, and is an example of free enterprise in action. In 2010, the company conducted a multi-state site search and moved their animal health business and corporate operations to Lancaster County and, since that time, has been actively engaged in the Lancaster community, including providing support to local schools, area law enforcement and fire services and many local charitable organizations.
