WHEREAS, programs offered by aquatics facilities around the state that educate the public about water safety play an important role in the prevention of drownings and recreational water-related injuries; and

WHEREAS, aquatics professionals help ensure water safety by developing rules and policies designed to guard against injury while fostering fun for the many people who participate in South Carolina's wide variety of aquatic-related recreational activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 2015 as

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to observe safety rules and practices when engaging in water-related recreational activities.
