**A Sense of Place: Lecture by 701 CCA Artist in Residence, Frank Poor**

**When: Monday, November 24, 7 p.m.**

Frank Poor is an American artist born in Woodstock, GA in 1962. He received his BFA from Georgia State University and MFA from Rhode Island School of Design. He is an artist in residence at 701 CCA until December 21 preparing and creating new work for his January-February exhibition at the center.

*For years now, I have returned to my native Southeast to photograph architecture and landscapes. These visits have been a way of reconnecting with my primary visual language. The resulting images are printed on various substrates and become the surfaces of three-dimensional architectural objects. The images of buildings are thus merged with their three-dimensional models. This presents two contradicting ways of telling, one through image and one through form. For me, that contradiction mirrors the slippage between our memories and what can be known about a place. That slippage has increasingly become the subject of my work. - Frank Poor*
