Subject: Leg Update

S. 516, Read to Succeed,

On the question of second reading of S.516, Read to Succeed, on April 1, Sen. Peeler proposed a strike and insert perfecting amendment, No. P1A, to the committee amendment. Senators Setzler and Malloy spoke on the perfecting amendment. The senate adjourned upon the motion of Sen. Malloy with him retaining the floor on the bill.

On April 2, the Senate resumed consideration of the bill, on the question of adoption of P1A. Sen. Malloy spoke on the perfecting amendment. Sen. Cleary asked unanimous consent, with Sen. Malloy holding the floor on S. 516, to take up H. 3412 on an uncontested basis. There was no objection. The committee amendment to H.3412 was adopted. On motion of Sen. Cleary, H. 3412 was carried over.

Sen. Malloy resumed speaking on P1A. Senator Shane Martin asked unanimous consent for a recess, Sen. Scott objected. Sen. Martin spoke on P1A then asked for unanimous consent to recommit S. 516 to the Committee on Finance retaining its place on the Calendar. Sen. Peer objected. Sen. Scott spoke on P1A and debate was interrupted by adjournment.
