Governor says elected officials arrested on DUIs should resign

S.C. Gov. Nikki Haley said Wednesday that Richland County councilman Kelvin Washington and Circuit Solicitor Donnie Myers, both recently arrested on drunken driving charges, should resign. When you look at elected officials that believe they are above the law, there's a problem," she told reporters at the State House. "I think

they both should resign. Our office is looking at options."

Haley can remove them from office only if they are indicted on a crime of so-called "moral turpitude," a broad legal term for acts that violate society norms.

Myers was arrested last week for drunken driving after the S.C. Highway Patrol responded to a car accident where Myers' car had run off the road and hit a utility pole.

Myers was arrested for driving under the influ-

ence in 2005, pleading guilty to the charge. In 2012, Myers was charged with having an open container of alcohol in his car. Efforts to reach Myers were unsuccessful Wednesday.

Richland County Councilman Kelvin Washington was charged with felony drunken driving after he crashed into another car Saturday night near Hopkins. The 22-year-old driver of the other car was taken to the hospital with serious injuries.

Washington's attorney, Michael Duncan, declined to comment Wednesday.
