Teachers are required to be finger printed as part of the certification process. The individual pays for this. They are also required to have a background check (BC). All other individuals are required to have a Background check and this is paid for by the district. If the district contracts out the service (food, janitorial) The background check is required, but up to the company whether or not the individual pays for it.
