Dear Senator Johnson:

As a practicing obstetrician/gynecologist in Clarendon county for more than 20 years, I need to bring a matter to your attention in hopes to resolve this issue before it contributes to the financial loss to any contraception providing physicians statewide.

**Listening to Your Problems:**

- Contraception
- Premenstrual symptoms
- Weight concerns
- Stress
- Breast Disorders
- Vaginal Discharge
- Sexual dysfunction
- Infertility
- Menstrual problems
- Sexually Transmitted Disease

The specifics of the matter involves reimbursements for Depo- Provera, the contraception that prevents pregnancy for 12-14 weeks. The CPT code J1055 which allowed for a \$43.50 reimbursement was deleted on December 31, 2012 by South Carolina Medicaid. It was replaced with a J1050 which only allows for a 20 cent/ unit (\$30.00) reimbursement for what cost me \$39.00 to provide.

My office contacted Medicaid and it has been over a month without a change. Medicaid says they are waiting for DHHS.

The importance of this issue will result in not offering this form of contraception by my office and others state wide and the teenage pregnancy rates will rise. I am requesting that you use your influence to resolve this matter because I cannot afford to be providing contraception to teens at my expense.

Thank you in advance for your assistance in this matter, and I look forward to hearing from you soon.
