Thank you for participating in yesterday's announcement and for supporting the consolidation of multiple crime victims services to the Attorney General's Office. We sincerely appreciate you taking the time to make this a priority in your busy, off-season schedule and look forward to your continued partnership on this effort next session: 803-413-5040. Here is a summary of information about the announcement, which we hope you find helpful:

Legislation – Laura Hudson is taking the lead on reducing the proposal to writing, including identifying statutory references that need to be amended and budget provisos that need to be codified. At this time, she is still taking feedback from stakeholders on details so please contact her with any specific questions. We plan to have the bill pre-filed in December and hope you will join as a sponsor.
