Spartanburg County will not let me obtain a bldg permit even though in the past as a registered architect with an ("unlimited ,assets greater than \$250,000") license as a construction manager I was allowed under state law to act as a genl contractor and could obtain a building permit.

However the Association of Genl Contractors must have lobbied the legislators to change that and now one must have a GC license without " grandfathering" people like me who did have that right previously.

In order to get a genl Contractors license I need to take 2 exams which is crazy since I have been building here and previously in NYC for over 40 yrs and I have been a registered architect since 1964.

I just think it is unfair to take away what I have and by the way the SC Dept of Licenses seems dysfunctional, they never return a phone call!

We are not being a user friendly state by doing things like this!
