Every two minutes, someone in the U.S. is sexually assaulted, and 60% of sexual assaults go unreported to the police. Most rape victims are between the ages of 10 and 24 years old, and over half the time are committed by people they know on some associate level. Does the fact that the accuser is a friend or acquaintance alter the credibility of the story being told?

Most recently, a fraternity at Duke University has been suspended after a female student reported being drugged and sexually assaulted at a frat party. That incident is under investigation. The fact that many sexual assaults are committed by people known to the victim might account for why so many assaults go unreported-- or why so many victims do not immediately report them.

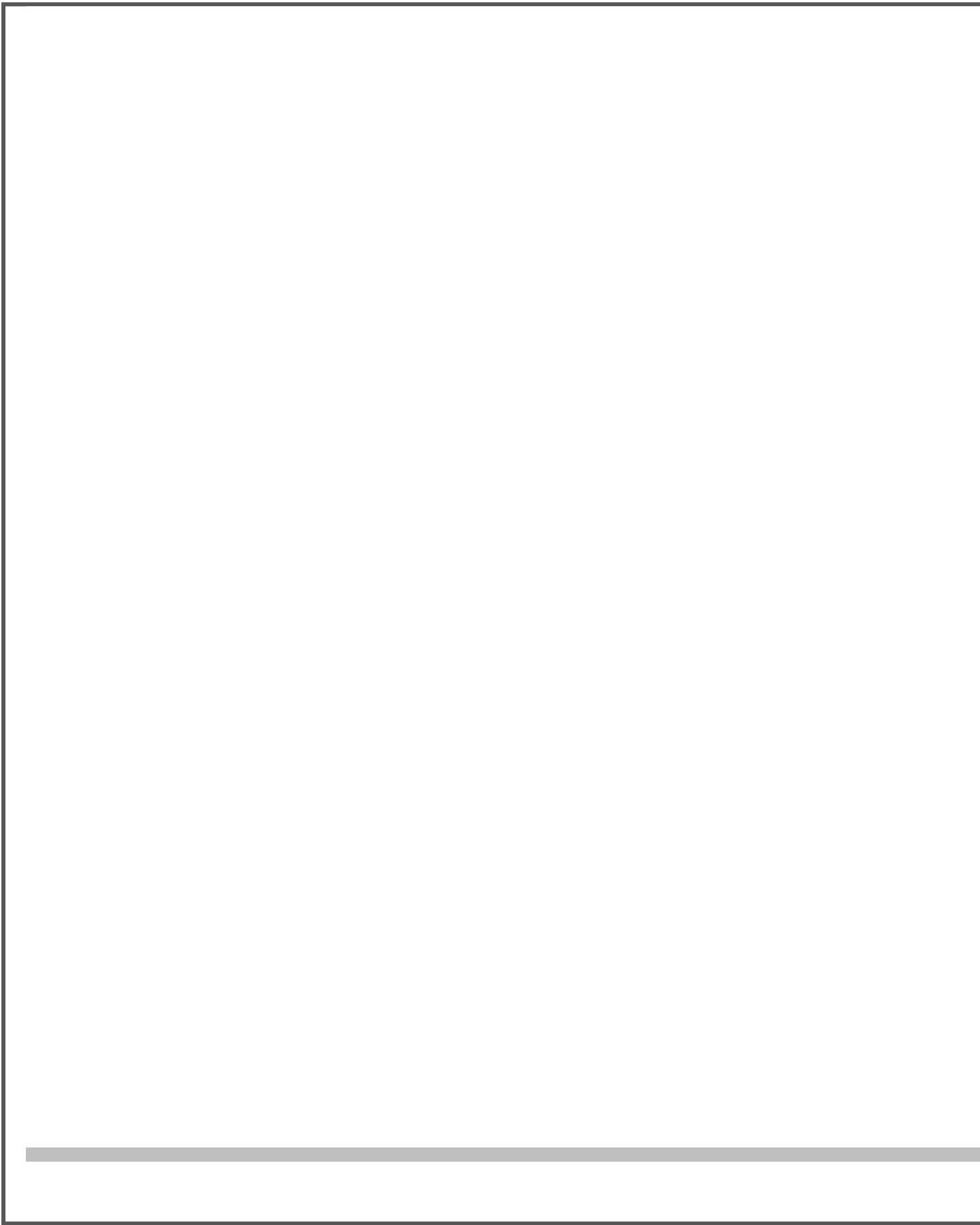
