The pond is approximately 8 acres in size and approximately 1,400 feet north-south by 400 feet east-west. The original earthendamb is about 650 feet long and includes a portion of the old alignment of Community Pond Road. The height is about 10 feet. No evidence was found during background research or during the field visit to suggest that this resource is part of a historic mill pond site.
