**RE: Palmetto Health Medical Price Gouging**

Dear Governor Haley,

Thank you for taking a moment to read this letter in the midst of other major issues in the state of SC. I would like to first thank you for all you do for the people of South Carolina.

What I'm writing you concerns all the people of South Carolina who need hospitalization, not just myself. I am writing you as my last recourse having spent months haggling with Palmetto Health over exorbitant and erroneous (in my estimation) hospital charges after Blue Cross Blue Shield paid them nearly \$18,000 for my husband's 48 hour stay at Parkridge. They finally issued a refund of \$1,257 but sent it to the insurance company instead of taking it off my remaining bill of \$2,590 (I already paid \$10). My husband, Michael, and I both have excellent credit because we are faithful in paying everything we owe and have worked diligently to maintain our good standing. This \$20,000+ hospital bill, however, is errant (in my estimation) yet Palmetto Health insists that we not only pay the \$2,590 in full, but that, if we can't, we must go through AccessOne causing us to pay even more money due to added interest.

This is not my first issue with Palmetto Health as my daughter, Sophia (now 12), has been seen at the children's ER to which the care was less than satisfactory on more than one occasion; nevertheless, I was stuck with huge bills even though my insurance company well compensated them. I've attached the previous letters I sent informing them of the issues I encountered as well as two letters thanking them for the excellent care at the hospital. My biggest issue is that Palmetto Health is blatantly price gouging people who have insurance under the rouse of legal operations; this is all while people who work the system so as to obtain free medical care pay nothing. I cannot imagine that the little care my husband received during his stay at their beautiful new and very

costly facility of Parkridge warranted a total bill exceeding \$20,000. I don't know how they can get away with this, though I'm sure their highly paid attorneys find every loophole possible.

Just some insight into my family's personal situation, my eldest daughter and I have had numerous medical issues over the last several years leading us both to have multiple surgeries/procedures, as well as countless doctor visits and medications. We've both been diagnosed with autoimmune diseases and, just a few months ago, discovered black mold in our home. My husband has felt the pressures of decreasing wages since 2009 as well. All of this has produced paramount financial strains to say the very least about the situation. I have no problem paying what we owe, but I do take serious issue with large corporations such as hospitals gouging people for money other people owe. I don't understand how Palmetto Health can get away with forcing people to pay interest on their bills (legitimate or illegitimate) or report them to a credit agency if they refuse (to pay interest). I have gone around and around with various staff members, but to no avail.

I have offered to pay some per month, but they refused. I have been paying them monthly without missing a payment for previous hospital bills yet, with their new policy, though I've offered to make payments we can afford, they will not work with me. Not only do I feel as though these charges are egregious and I don't *want* to pay, we *cannot* pay. Although we are all but bankrupt, we are willing to work with the hospital yet they are unwilling to work with us in a reasonable fashion. I find this to be criminal.

If there is any possible way you can assist us in this very serious matter which concerns most South Carolinians, I will be humbled and grateful.

**RE: Parkridge Palmetto Hospital, General Care**

To whom it may concern,

I went to the ER at approximately 10:30am, March 13, 2015 and was discharged around 11:30am, March 15, 2015. Although the staff was extremely courteous, the care was not satisfactory.

When I arrived at the ER, they took me back nearly immediately, which was great. They gave me morphine for pain, IV fluids, and antibiotics. The nurse was very caring and the doctor was nice. However, after a CT, it was confusing as to whether or not I had an obstruction or a hernia as both were mentioned; that confusion lasted up until I was discharged. I was in the ER approximately 5 ½ hours. In that time I received only one bag of fluids though I was extremely dehydrated. They also administered a nasal tube to siphon my stomach hoping to alleviate the blockage, which it did and the pain subsided considerably.

When they moved me to the fourth floor, I was told I would receive another bag of fluids. This is where the real problem arose. For four hours, although the nurses attached my tube to the machine, they didn't turn on the pressure in order to continue the pumping. Additionally, they never gave me another bag of fluids. My wife asked a nurse about it and she said they'd check – I still never received another bag. I lay there four hours without any assistance from anyone. We assumed there was nothing more to pump.

Dr. Mirra came in around 8pm. My wife expressed to him the lack of pumping, that the machine was not turned on and, when he turned the knob, it immediately began to pump bile as it had in

**RE: Poor ER Care**

Dear Doctor Gerard,

To my deepest chagrin, this is my second letter to you about the worst possible care from your ER staff. My nine year old child had three bouts of ear infections since November 14<sup>th</sup>. With each round, she had a headache, but with the last bout, she developed one so severe starting December 7<sup>th</sup> that did not subside no matter what we administered. It grew quickly to a level 10 and lasted until December 16<sup>th</sup> after she was finally hospitalized under the care of pediatrics neurologist, Dr. Harley Morgan, MD., on Friday, December 14<sup>th</sup>.

December 12<sup>th</sup>, our family doctor (Lake Murray Family Practice) sent us to the ER specifically instructing us to have a spinal tap and CT. Your doctor insisted that the spinal tap was not necessary – ridiculous even because there was “zero percent change that she has meningitis”; he didn’t consider that something else could be the issue.

He gave her Lortab for the pain, but she was allergic and then given Benadryl. He was going to send her home because “She could have a headache for hundreds of reasons.” I responded that going home in her condition was unacceptable. I had to insist on the CT, though he convinced me that a spinal tap was vastly unnecessary. I asked for something else for pain and he suggested Oxycodone which I refused. He finally sent her home with phenegan but it was useless to her pain. I said I wanted her admitted but he refused this also, even after detailing all that had transpired and that nothing touches her pain even while sleeping.

The next day, our GP made a call to his friend, Dr. Morgan, who insisted that she come in immediately. As it happens, the spinal tap was vital to her recovery as she had **a-typical mycoplasma** – something that could have caused spinal or brain issues or worse. I cannot express in mere words my disgust for the profoundly poor service at your ER. Even the senior doctor came in and evaluated her as probably having migraines and seemed completely disinterested in my plea for help. I am certain that my ER bill will be astronomical which means I will be billed for someone who not only did not help, but needlessly prolonged the continuation of my child’s pain that could have put her life in jeopardy. I have no problem paying for quality care as my child’s life is priceless. But, when you charge exorbitant fees for nothing more than a flippant and thoughtless prognosis, I must decline payment.

On the flip side, the service at the children’s hospital was phenomenal and I gladly pay the cost. Both as a minister and as a mother, I desire to be rational and respectful, always open to seeing every point of view, but there is nothing positive to say about the absolute worst care of your ER. For me to drive across town to your

ER, I must believe my child's care cannot wait, especially upon the insistence of our primary care physician. Since my physicians do not make rounds, they could not admit her directly or they would have. I was left to the mercy of your employees; a sad day, indeed.

I hope that you will take strong action in this matter, not for Sophia as she is on the mend, but for future cases that are not textbook. As Dr. Morgan says, "I have learned to listen more to mothers than to preliminary tests. Those who pay attention to their children know when something is really wrong." May God grant all doctors such wisdom and act accordingly.

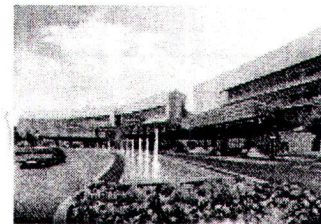
