MINUTES OF STATE BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD MEETING

JULY 25, 1962

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The State Budget and Control Board met in the Office of the Director of Sinking Funds and Property at 11:30 A. M., on July 25, 1962. All members of the Board were present at this meeting.

The Board reconsidered its action of June 26 and permitted the increase of five salaries in the Department of Agriculture and one salary in the Insurance Commissioner's Office to the amounts originally requested for these salaries.

The Board postponed action on the request of the Penitentiary to rent a warehouse from the Jeff Hunt Road Machinery Company to use for offices and for the storage of manufacturing material for the Industries there.

The Board discussed at length the request of the State Department of Education to be permitted to receive Federal Funds for training unemployed manpower in South Carolina. It was brought out that the Federal Government would finance this program in full for the first two years, and that thereafter the State would be asked to contribute 50% of its cost. The Board did not approve the acceptance of this Federal Aid at this meeting, but agreed to hear the State Superintendent of Education on the matter at the Board's next meeting.

The Board allotted from the 1961-1962 Civil Contingent Fund to the Secretary of State the sum of \$812.96 for Office Supplies and the amount of \$32.53 to supplement the appropriation for Administration of the Securities Act.

The Board allotted from the 1962-1963 Civil Contingent Fund the following sums:

The Southern Interstate Nuclear Board	\$ 3,500.00
The S. C. State College - Expense for Entertainment of the National Association of Negro Agricultural Agents (which is to be held at the State College, in Orangeburg, July 22 - 25)	\$ 500.00

The Governor and State Auditor were authorized to investigate the request of the Adjutant General to supply some token of recognition to members of the National Guard who were recently sent over seas. The amount authorized was not to exceed \$3,000.00.

The Board agreed to underwrite to the State Tax Commission the sum of \$6,108.00, or to permit the Commission to use that amount of the Income Tax Revenue, for the rental of certain necessary machines and an operator to facilitate reconciliation with the office of the State Treasurer.

The Board approved the remodeling of two residences occupied by the Director of Mental Health, and the State Hospital Superintendent, at costs of approximately \$17,000.00 for one and about \$25,000.00 for the other, the costs to be paid from bond funds authorized for the institution.

The Board agreed to supplant the appropriation for the Poet Laureate in the amount of \$600.00 for the fiscal year 1962-63.

The Board agreed to supply funds for printing of the Banking Laws of the State as carried in the 1962-Code of Laws.

The Board authorized the Director of Sinking Funds and Property to proceed with the purchase of the American Legion property on Senate Street for the use of the proposed new State Office Building, at the optioned price of \$250,000.00.

The Board then adjourned.

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
