

## National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS)

The NMVTIS funding policy is based on a tiered pricing arrangement similar to the AAMVA dues structure. The jurisdictions are divided into a total of 10 pricing tiers, split evenly across the jurisdictions. There are a total of 6 jurisdictions in the first tier, and 5 jurisdictions in each of the remaining 9 tiers, totaling 51 jurisdictions. Tier ranking for each jurisdiction will be determined using the same vehicle registration statistics used to calculate the AAMVA membership dues. A copy of the current tier ranking is attached. The tier ranking will be revised annually.

Please note effective October 1, 2007, all states that pay NMVTIS fees will be required to pay the full annual fee, regardless of the number of states participating in NMVTIS. This was a decision approved by the AAMVA Board in January 2006.

Previously, the fee structure was prorated based on the total number of participating jurisdictions.
