My father the real William Mc Queen would have turned 100 years old on June 12, 2014. But 42 years ago he past.

His estate remains unsettled in the City of Charleston, SC.

His great, great, great grandfather, the late John Mc Queen received Royal Land Grants, State Plots and Colonial Plots from King George II & III, throughout history.

In 1975 my father's estate was suppose to go into litigation, but it was rescheduled.

Instead Governor James B Edwards, who was once Secretary of Energy, he signed a quit claim deed, that under the constitution of South Carolina, he was not authorized to sign, claiming properties of my late father (Deed S117-330)

The City of Charleston under quit claim H107-34 also claimed properties of my late father

Another William Mc Queen was created and my father's properties are listed in deed A215-116.

and a number of deeds and ~~two~~ other estates were created
In 1990 there was a division of my grandfather's
properties

my grandfather Joseph McQueen died October 1918.

Now two more Estates were created under deed A 219-325.

Everyone was placed in default except me.

also in Berkeley County, South Carolina (Deed 3325-98)

which on page 146 of this deed is Joseph McQueen's
properties of my grandfather and I'm paying the taxes.

In 1988 Myrna Scott (Joy-White-McQueen-Vass) Dickinson

my half sister had her name changed from Myrna Scott to

Myrna McQueen by filing in court that she is William McQueen
only daughter 16 years after his death, and of course she
has part of his estates

the year my father died, the chief of Police for Charleston S.C. at
that time got on TV and told how lawyers from all over
the country was coming to S.C. claiming properties.

the properties of the late William McQueen, one lawyer
has his name on the deed and the partner acted as the
notary.

I have Inheritance Waivers as well as a document
called a "Letter" for properties, But Greg Edwards
of Probate Court in Charleston is blocking my claim!!!

I have been fighting for my properties for over 40 years. and
have published over 12 books about my search and my findings
I need your help !!!
