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Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services Announce Funding Opportunity for Marketplace Navigators

New Three-Year Project Period

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is now accepting applications for funding to support Navigators in Federally-facilitated Marketplaces (FFM), including State Partnership Marketplaces. Navigators provide objective information about health coverage to help consumers make the best possible choice. They are knowledgeable about qualified health plans in the Marketplaces, and public programs including Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program.

Funding is available to eligible individuals, as well as private and public entities, applying to serve as Navigators in states with a FFM. Grantees will be selected for a three-year project period, and a total of up to \$67 million is available for the first year of the award.

This funding opportunity is open to new and returning HHS Navigator grant applicants. Applications are due by **June 15, 2015**.
