

November 5, to 8, 1945.

The Budget Commission met in the Governor's office at 10:00 a. m. and 3:00 p. m. on November 5, 6, 7, and 8. All members of the Commission attended these hearings.

At each of these meetings, department and institutional authorities were present and discussed with the Budget Commission their appropriation needs for the ensuing fiscal year. All of the meetings of this week, with the exception of the afternoon meeting on November 8, were devoted exclusively to discussions of Budgets presented by the various departments and institutions.

At the afternoon meeting of November 8, the following transfer was approved by the Commission:

The South Carolina Tax Commission - From the Income Tax Revenue
\$12,057.50 for use of the Income Tax Division - Field Agents
\$6,000.00, Clerks - \$1,950.00, Travel - \$3,000.00, Office
Equipment - \$1,107.50.

The following allotments were also approved from the Civil Contingent

Fund:

The R. L. Bryan Company - \$56.50 for Budget Supplies.

Edgar A. Brown - Expense to Washington on October 4 to 10 inclusive as representative of the Governor at the Governor's Conference on Surplus Property Disposal - \$229.18.

The Governor's Office
Salary and travel of Industrial Agent - 2 months - \$1,066.67.

The Insurance Commissioner's Office - \$2,800.00 - salary of Deputy Commissioner - November 1, 1945 to June 30, 1946.

The Commission then adjourned.
