1. Deposits are required at the time of reservation. Your deposit may be made by check or credit card. The credit card must belong to the reservation holder or if not, when checking in, you will need an authorization form from the credit card holder if the guest name is different. When using a credit card a one night deposit will be charged when making the reservation. 3. All food and beverage served in the hotel must be provided by the hotel. Any items brought into the hotel will be subject to a corkage fee, applicable service charge and tax.
4. Reservations must be received no later than **January 11, 2016** to obtain special pricing.
