My name is David Hatfield. I am a Federal ranger at J. Strom Thurmond Lake (Clarks Hill Lake) located near Augusta, Georgia. In order to reduce water-related fatalities, we have an agreement with a local news station, Channel 6 - WJBF, to produce and air water safety PSA's for the upcoming 4th of July and Labor Day weekends. We were hoping an influential public figure would be willing to do a 30 second public service announcement encouraging people to practice safe recreational water habits. Our agency - U.S. Army Corps of Engineers would provide the script for review. Our target audience is everyone, but especially males between the ages of 16 to 50 years old.
