Dams - Due to the heavy rains throughout the state, the following dams are being monitored: Upper Pelzer, Buzzard Roost, Loblolly, Lake Chinquapin, and Hunt Mills. Officials from DHEC, SCEMD, and the counties will continue to monitor these dams.

Roads - Also, roads in multiple counties have been closed: Greenwood, Chester, Lancaster, Chesterfield, Abbeville, and Laurens Counties have been affected. EMD will continue to monitor.

There have been no reports of injuries. No state assistance has been requested.
