The State Budget and Control Board met in the Governor's office at 10:00 A. M. on April 29, 1959. All members of the Board were present.

The Governor presented a bill from the Council of State Governments in the amount of \$3,500.00 for support of the South's Regional Advisory Council on Nuclear Energy, sponsored by the Southern Governors' Conference, as the State's contribution. Payment of this bill was approved.

The Board approved an allotment of \$500.00 from the Civil Contingent Fund to defray the current year's expenses of the Confederate Centennial Commission.

The State Auditor submitted a statement of expenditures from the Civil Contingent Fund for the current year, showing a balance of \$40,589.86 as of April 24, 1959.

The Board authorized the payment of \$1,500.00 to Moody's Investment Service as advisor to the State Treasurer on the investment of State Funds.

The Board authorized the expenditure of not to exceed \$1,300.00 to renovate the offices of the State Development Board.

The Board agreed to extend its policies with the World Wide Insurance Company on school buses, property damage and liability, until next year at which time both policies would be re-negotiated.

After a full discussion the Board agreed to request legislation necessary to construct an office building on the corner of Senate and Marion Streets and to sponsor necessary legislation therefor at this session of the Legislature.

The Board then adjourned.
