WHEREAS, clean water plays a vital role in the economic prosperity of South Carolina by providing a sustainable commercial fishing industry and a robust tourism industry while keeping our beaches pristine and maintaining our agricultural industry; and

WHEREAS, the Association of State and Interstate Water Pollution Control Administrators is the independent, national organization of state and interstate water program directors who on a daily basis implement the water quality programs of the Clean Water Act and ensure clean, safe water across our nation; and

WHEREAS, this year, the Association of State and Interstate Water Pollution Control Administrators is celebrating its fiftieth anniversary.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim August 14-20, 2011, as
