North Charleston Mayor Keith Summey announced Wednesday that the city will supply more than 200 body cameras for the police force. Summey noted that was enough for every officer to wear one.

Mayor Summey made that announcement after the release of a video showing Officer T. Slager fatally shooting 50-year-old Walter Scott on Saturday. Scott was unarmed when he was attempting to flee. The video shows Slager chasing Scott, then shooting at Scott several times in the back before he collapses. He doesn't appear to be threatened as he'd claim.

Because of the video tape Officer Slager had been arrested and charged with murder. But what if the video tape didn't exist? Many are concerned that Slager almost got away with his crime. The original version of events appears initially to have been believed.

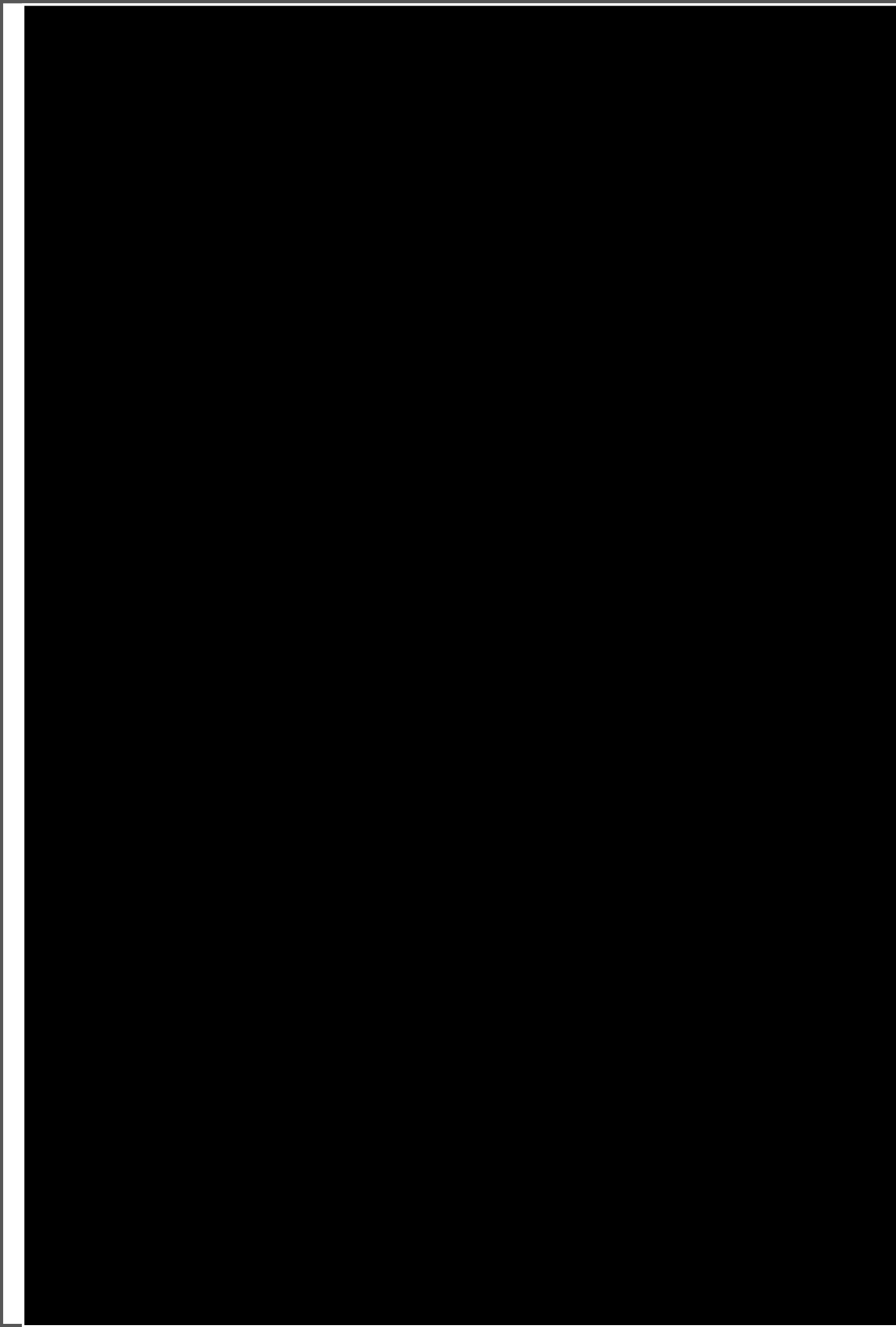
"I was always known as the smart kid. I performed with a band on the side but I had so many gigs that I ended up quitting my engineering job because music took over me being an engineer."
