I'm doing a story today on the fact that state agencies don't have a uniform computer security plan almost 18 months after the DOR hacking.

One problem is that there's no law or requirement for them to have a plan, or even for agencies to all be monitored by the Dept. of State Information Technology, DSIT.

Sen. Joel Lourie said he thinks Gov. Haley should have issued an executive order forcing all state agencies to be monitored by DSIT. I remember she did something along those lines with her cabinet agencies. I wanted to check with you to see whether she has done anything like that, if so whether it was just her cabinet agencies, and if not why not?
