Subject: Regulatory Reform Executive Order

Per your request, I have prepared a draft Executive Order which directs cabinet agencies and encourages all other executive agencies to perform a comprehensive review of proposed and current regulations that unduly burden SC's businesses using certain criteria.

The EO also requires that the agencies work with the Small Business Regulatory Review Committee (a committee created by the Small Business Regulatory Flexibility Act of 2004) to do a similar review for small business regulatory relief. I have spoken with the staff at Commerce that works with the Committee (made of small business owners) and he is excited about this Order which he believes the Committee will be able to provide valuable input (they are also required by law to perform this type of review every 5 years anyway and haven't). Bobby Hitt was scheduled to call the Gov yesterday about other issues and wanted to discuss this as well. I haven't gotten a follow up about that conversation yet.

I'm working on talking points and examples of existing burdensome regulations (primarily from LLR).
