Certification and registration requirements were established by law to monitor nursery products for harmful insects and diseases and to prevent noxious weeds from invading the state.

## **Commissioner's Column**

### **2001--- An eventful journey**

In the movie, 2001-A Space Odyssey, when all seemed hopeless, a computer with human-like qualities named Hal comforted his friend saying, "I've still got the greatest enthusiasm and confidence in the mission..."

Now that the real 2001 is almost over, we can repeat Hal's words---we've still got the greatest enthusiasm and confidence in the mission. The mission for agriculture is providing food, shelter, and clothing for every man, woman, and child in this state and nation.

Many issues affected the business of agriculture this year, including low farm level prices versus high production costs, adverse weather, new regulations and risks of foreign animal diseases.

Although farmers worked harder and smarter this year and produced higher yields, prices remained low and production costs high.

Perhaps one of the biggest issues in agriculture over the past few years has been the weather. Well-timed rains did manage to help produce a good corn crop---the first good crop in several years. Unfortunately, even with a few days of rain, the dry weather trend threatens the yields of hay in some area and later harvested crops.

Once again new regulations concerning farmers were proposed in 2001. The pork industry in South Carolina is faced with state emergency regulations that could possibly become permanent, thus barring future production in our state. The 25-mile setback will drastically alter the pork industry, affecting farmers with large facilities that produce one million pounds of hogs per year.

The agricultural industry also had to learn to deal with the potential outbreak of foreign animal diseases. Although we are not facing a direct threat at this time, precautions were and are being taken to make sure these diseases continue to stay out of our state and nation. For the safety of the animals on the farm, and for people in general, visitors to countries infected with diseases such as BSE and foot and mouth are being asked to stay away from livestock farms.

Several of the new regulations have come as a result of conflicts between rural and urban people. As the cities get more crowded, people begin to move into the rural areas, where they are close to farms. After a hectic day at work, they return to their home out in the country and are faced with what they consider offensive smells and sounds. Before these people move to the country though, they need to understand that they are relocating to an agricultural environment---an environment in which the sounds and smells are part of the effort to put food on their tables. We should all be thankful for the men and women who don't mind the unpleasant sounds and smells of farming---those who don't mind the dust blowing in their faces. If we didn't have these people, I wonder where we'd get our food. I wonder if we'd be totally dependent on foreign countries. For farmers and consumers ---this is serious business!

In addition to all these other issues, the SC Department of Agriculture had to face one of its biggest challenges yet. Due to a shortfall in the state coffers, the SCDA's budget was cut 12% last June and another 4% in November. More cuts loom on the horizon according to officials who tend the state's pocketbook. Sixteen percent is a tough blow to an agency that has always been frugal!

Unfortunately, like in any business, when the cost of an operation inflates, the resulting costs get passed down to the customer. In order to guarantee that your food is safe, that you get what you pay for at the gas tank, and that you continue to get quality SC products, we have had to increase fees to our customers---which means you, the consumer, are affected.

Although there were many factors hindering agriculture in 2001, our state's farmers are diversifying and looking for ways to add value to their operations. Alternative uses for traditional agricultural crops and the introduction of new plants and animals further brighten agriculture's economic future.

The real 2001 was not a space odyssey, but it was, indeed, and eventful journey of epic proportions for us all---farmers and non-farmers. Some of the trip we would like to forget. Some of the trip we will savor. But, by looking back on the past, we learn how to move forward to the future.

From all of us at the South Carolina Department of Agriculture, we wish you a very Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.

## **Summit on Agriculture and Natural Resources Scheduled**

The Third Annual Governor's Summit on Agriculture and Natural Resources will be held on Thursday, February 7, 2002 at the Adams Mark Hotel in Columbia, SC, from 10 a.m. until 7 p.m.

In support of the summit, Governor Jim Hodges said, "Agriculture and natural resources are vital to the health and well-being of our State's economy. I want to encourage anyone with an interest in the future of these industries to come and participate in the summit as we develop a roadmap for the future. South Carolina farmers do more than help provide food, clothing, and shelter, they also help grow American pride."

Participants will hear from leading authorities on the topics of bio-security and safety, proposed regulations of the state's livestock industries, water use and conservation practices by farmers; property rights and land preservation in rural South Carolina, and what alternative crops are realistic for South Carolina farmers to consider. Afterwards, participants will be invited to join working discussion groups as they help draft an action report for submission to the Governor and other state policy makers.

Candidates who have filed their intentions to run for SC Commissioner of Agriculture by February 7th will be invited to participate in a "Meet the Candidates" session during the summit.
