110-span T-beam bridge that carries southbound U.S. 301 over the South Edisto Swamp. It was constructed in 1933 and is 300 feet long. The 1933 section was 22 feet wide and consisted of four concrete beams carried by reinforced concrete Tbeam bents. It was expanded on both sides in 1973 and currently measures 43.5 feet wide.
