Section 2 - Motor Fuel User Fee - .12 phased in at .02 a year for 6 years, no future CPI adjustment

Section 3 - Motor Carrier Fee - equivalent to Motor Fuel User Fee (I think this was approved) and corresponding credit

Section 4 - Increase in vehicle registration fee - Approved

Section 5 - Sales Tax on vehicles increased not to exceed \$500 and fee for vehicles coming in from out of state. - I'm not sure what in all they did with this section

Section 6 - fees on alt fuel vehicles - approved

Section 7 - increase in sales tax on vehicles not subject to user fee under 5. (Not sure)

Section 8 - Motor Carrier changes (not sure what they did here)

Section 9 - Increase license fees (I think this was not approved)
