

500 Seek Places In Housing Project

Five hundred applications for apartments in Gonzales Gardens, low rent housing project, have been received by the Columbia housing authority.

This project is expected to be opened in September, William R. Geddings, manager of the projects, said today. A definite date for opening the project has not been fixed.

In spite of the fact that only 236 apartments will be available, the housing authority is continuing to receive applications because many already received are ineligible due to the salary bracket being higher than the maximum fixed by the housing authority.

Work is continuing on Allen-Benedict court and it is expected that this project will be completed in October.
