According to our 2012 Rat Log and Veto Folder, there were only two unconstitutional local bills that were **ratified**:

1. H.4723 (Berea) – overridden by the House (97-0) and sustained by the Senate (38-0)
2. H.3790 (Bamberg) – overridden by the House (55-5) and overridden by the Senate (20-10)

The corresponding veto messages for these two bills are attached.

FYI – There were (at least) three unconstitutional local bills that were passed by the House but were never voted on by the Senate (ie. three “golf cart” bills). Also, remember that there were several constitutional local bills that were signed/vetoed based on policy – not unconstitutionality (ie. school and special purpose district bills).
