
Dear Governor Nikki R. Haley,

As governors, we have the ability to spread awareness, educate the public, and ensure that all available resources are utilized to combat this heinous crime. We have implemented a multipronged approach in the State of Maine by encouraging law enforcement to target the pimps who profit from the victim's misery, the Johns who drive the industry by paying for services, and we've also encouraged service providers to work together to find placement and treatment services for the victims once they've been rescued.
