Everything went very, very well at the news conference today with Gov. Haley and SRR President Dave Olson talking about saving schools money. Doug did a great job organizing it and pulling it off, and the Governor was glowing about SRR in her comments, which was much appreciated!

I wanted to let you know that when Dave and the Governor were walking off the stage, she asked him "What's next?" in terms of more outreach like this. He said he'd like to be able to do more work in schools, and other companies with Six Sigma workers like ours (many large companies have them) could help. He mentioned that appearing before some group like the state school board folks might be a step in the right direction, if she wants to pursue school savings statewide through the Six Sigma program. She answered that she liked the idea, and the discussion ended there. (If you remember, when Dave sat down with you, there were other possibilities for this work as well, such as state agencies.)

I say all this to let you know about the conversation, and to decide if you guys want to pursue going farther with this concept. It's up to you, of course. We'll stand ready to do what you need us to. Just let me know what you think!
