"An Acceptable Risk?" Cannon Demonstrations (3)*
Feel the ground quake beneath your feet as the Charles Towne Militia fires reproduction 17th-century cannons. Times: 12pm, 2pm, & 4pm at the Cannon Platforms.

From Flint to Flame: Colonial Fire-starting (2)
Watch and listen as a costumed interpreter demonstrates historic fire-starting techniques. Times: 1:30pm & 3:30pm outside the Common House.

Archaeology

Miller Site Excavation (10)
Visit with archaeologists at our active dig site and learn about tabby, a colonial form of concrete made from lime, oyster shells, ash, sand, and water. Follow the "Ongoing Excavations" signs on the History Trail to the dig site's location. From 11am - 3:30pm.

Ongoing Activities

The Adventure and Albemarle Point (4)
While at Albemarle Point, board the Adventure, a replica of a 17th-century trading sloop, where you will learn about the rigors of a sailor's life. Also discover what products the colonists traded to make Carolina an economic success. From 10am - 5pm.

Open-Hearth Cooking (2)
See what's on the menu at the Common House as costumed interpreters prepare a colonial meal. Food is for demonstration purposes only. From 10am - 4pm at the Common House.

Colonial Encampment (8)
Meet reenactors in their camp and talk to them about daily life in early Charles Towne. From 10am - 5pm.
