**The NOAH Project**

The Noah Project is a program operated by the ARK Respite Center in Summerville. The mission of the NOAH Project is to create respite programs to ease the burden of caregivers in rural South Carolina. It used the Fund to help to create a respite program in Harleyville.

**Memory Matters**

Memory Matters is also a respite program. It is located on Hilton Head Island. Memory Matters uses the Fund to expand its hours of operation by offering caregivers the chance to get respite in the evenings.

**Lakeview Community Center**

The Lakeview Community center is located in West Columbia. It uses the Fund to provide special programming for a senior center in a limited resource community.

Attached are two versions of the PSA script. One is a monologue and the second is a combination of testimonies from the Lt. Governor and individuals personally benefiting from the Harleyville respite center and the Lakeview Community Center.
