Eastbound I-20 Reopened in Kershaw County

A section of Interstate 20 eastbound in Kershaw County was reopened shortly before 12:30 pm Sunday, May 15, after recovery of a tractor-trailer that crashed into the Wateree River earlier this month.

The closure was necessary for two heavy duty tow trucks to set up on the eastbound bridge and extract the trailer and rig from the river below.

On May 1, the tractor trailer crashed through guardrail and landed in the river.
