**SIXTH ANNUAL WOUNDED HEROES GOLF
CLASSIC AIMS TO RAISE OVER \$185,000**

BLUFFTON, SC-The Lowcountry Foundation for Wounded Military Heroes will host the sixth annual Wounded Heroes Golf Classic at Hampton Hall on Monday, May 16, 2016. Building on the tremendous success of previous events, which have raised over **\$500,000**, the LFWMH hopes to surpass last year's donation total of **\$185,000**. Funds are donated to the *Birdies for the Brave*, operated by the PGA TOUR, which acts as a conduit for distributing funds to vetted charities that benefit wounded military heroes. Each year the LFWMH selects those charities which have demonstrated an ability to reach and positively impact wounded heroes in the Lowcountry and coastal Georgia.

Two years ago, a special relationship was initiated with K9's FOR WARRIORS, based in Jacksonville, Florida, and started by Shari Duval, mother of champion golfer David Duval. This organization provides dogs rescued from shelters and trains them as service K9's to be given to veterans suffering from PTSD symptoms. So far the Foundation has financed 7 dogs through the program, with the first two named 'Berkeley' and 'Hampton' to honor our supporters and volunteers from Berkeley Hall and Hampton Hall. 'Berkeley' and his new owner, Corporal Rick Smith (US Army), will again be one of the honored guests at this year's event. In addition, Shari Duval will be the Keynote speaker at the Awards dinner on Monday night.



On Monday, May 16, 224 donors will tee off and play 18 holes at either Hampton Hall or Belfair golf clubs, and they will be joined by 25 special guests, who are wounded veterans from local Army, Navy, and Marine Corps units. The spectacular Opening Ceremonies will start at 11:00 AM behind the Hampton Hall Golf Clubhouse, and they will feature the following:

- The Special Forces Association Parachute Team from Fort Bragg ,NC will send six jumpers(with two tandem passengers) into the skies to deliver the colors simultaneously to Hampton Hall and Belfair.
- SgtMajor Dwayne Farr(USMC,ret),assisted by Marine Corps JROTC cadets from Whale Branch High School, will play “America the Beautiful” on the bagpipes.
- Mayor Lisa Sulka will read a special Proclamation from the Town Board
- The Bluffton Police Honor Guard will post the colors.
- The National Anthem will be sung by owners and cast members of the Savannah Theatre.

Several hundred volunteers , residents of Hampton Hall, and invited guests will be in attendance. Following golf, activities will conclude with a dinner, silent/live auctions, and an awards ceremony at the Hampton Hall community clubhouse. Local individuals and businesses have enthusiastically supported this event, and the generous people of the Lowcountry will again demonstrate their profound support for our military heroes.This year,several of the LFWMH designated charities will be in attendance,along with wounded heroes and their families who have been helped by our efforts.
