Edisto Beach State Park has suffered major effects from Hurricane Irma. Park Director Gaines and our state park team have assessed the damage and provided the photos below. The oceanfront campground was flooded by storm surge on the marsh side, and saltwater infiltrated and severely damaged the electrical system. The Live Oak campground is littered with downed trees and limbs after Irma, and a tornado associated with it, damaged the area. In order for us to clean up and make repairs to both campgrounds, they will be closed for the remainder of the 2017 calendar year. The day-use area (with beach access) and cabin area of Edisto Beach State Park will reopen on September 22. If you have camping reservations between now and the end of 2017, you will be contacted and a full refund issued. Any cabin reservations affected will also be refunded.
