The White House recently announced that it will convene a White House Conference on Aging next year, as it has done each decade since the 1960s. As you know, 2015 marks the 50th anniversary of Medicare, Medicaid, and the Older Americans Act, as well as the 80th anniversary of Social Security. The 2015 White House Conference on Aging is an opportunity to recognize the importance of these key programs as well as to look ahead to the issues that will help shape the landscape for older Americans for the next decade. To listen and learn from key aging leaders and older Americans, the Administration will participate in listening sessions with older Americans and advocates across the country starting in August and continuing throughout the year.

The Home and Community-Based Services Conference will offer an opportunity to participate in a Listening Session on the 2015 Conference. White House Conference on Aging Executive Director, Nora Super, and Assistant Secretary for Aging, Kathy Greenlee, will join us on Wednesday, September 17 afternoon to gather input from HCBS Conference attendees on issues regarding retirement security, healthy aging, long-term supports and
