WHEREAS, professional land surveyors give shape to our transportation routes, water systems, and communities and to many other technical facets that make up our nation's infrastructure; and

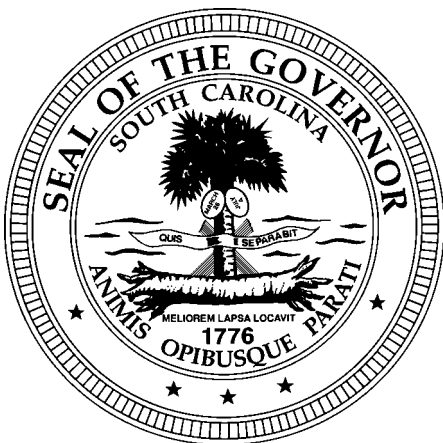
WHEREAS, professional land surveyors create permanent records of land ownership for future generations; and
