**Subject:** SCDOT Secretary Hall's Annual State of the SCDOT Report



Interim Secretary of Transportation Christy A. Hall presented the “State of SCDOT” report for 2016 to the SCDOT Commission at its monthly January meeting in Columbia earlier this week.

The annual review provided the current status of South Carolina’s transportation network. The overall assessment by Interim Secretary Hall is summed up in these four points:

1. Most South Carolinians are riding on poor pavements.
2. Most bridges are in good condition, but there are high-risk areas that need to be addressed.
3. Day-to-Day maintenance is graded a “D.”
4. Congestion is increasing and will impact SC’s economic competitiveness.

Secretary Hall also presented her vision of the agency in an effort to make SCDOT more effective as well as initiatives to improve the agency’s transparency and accountability.
