USDA Secretary Dan Glickman recently announced approval of the Foothills Resource Conservation and Development Area for the upstate, one of 33 areas selected nationwide. The Foothills RC&D covers Anderson, Greenville, Oconee, Pickens, and Spartanburg Counties and is the seventh area in the state, completing RC&D coverage for all South Carolina counties. Rapid growth in the Upstate threatens the area's sensitive natural areas and approval of the Foothills RC&D area ensures that funding and support will be available to help protect these precious natural resources.

"The Foothills RC&D will serve as an excellent community development resource for citizens in the Upstate," commented Walter W. Douglas, state conservationist with the USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS). "Coupled with available technical and financial assistance, these communities can continue solving natural resource concerns at the local level." NRCS provides a local coordinator to ensure access to USDA programs for community development projects. RC&D projects provide practical solutions for community development, land conservation, environmental enhancement, and water management. Areas are locally led by councils comprised of volunteers, civic leaders, and locally elected officials.

The Foothills RC&D Council was organized in October 1999 and has since completed many successful projects in the areas of water quality improvement, stream stabilization, and community enhancement. On Groundhog Day, February 2nd, a groundhog named Punxsutawney Phil peeps from out of his home to predict the upcoming weather. If Phil sees his shadow and runs back into his hole, six more weeks of winter face the country. If the groundhog does not see his shadow, he will stay outside, therefore predicting the conclusion to wintry weather.

Although a groundhog cannot accurately determine the season's weather any more than you or I, climatologists with the SC Department of Natural Resources can do a much better job. Using figures from the past year, recent precipitation, and the history of weather cycles, SCDNR climatologists can give a fair prediction of this upcoming year's weather. In addition, they can determine whether or not the state will face another drought, or whether we may have normal or adequate rainfall.

Recent rains have helped keep the topsoil moist, so the outlook for spring plantings is positive. If we were to receive normal rainfall, then the prospect would be for a great growing season. The current precipitation is anywhere from .5 to 1 inch below average though, which maintains the drought status for SC counties from October of last year. Eleven counties are still experiencing an incipient drought and thirty-five counties a moderate drought.

A drought can occur in virtually all climatic zones and is a normal recurrent feature. It is a deficiency of precipitation over an extended period of time. The past year was a dry one, some areas needed up to 11 inches of precipitation to end their dry spells. What does the future hold?

Milt Brown, Associate State Climatologist, tells a trying story for the state. If projections are correct, SC farmers could face another tough growing season. Right now reservoirs, rivers, and groundwater are below normal. Even though topsoil is in good condition, impending dryness could cause problems. The outlook for tropical storms and hurricanes is less than last year as well, albeit a normal number for the state. All of these factors combined with predictions for higher temperatures could lead to another drought year.

In order to prepare for the upcoming months, we should all begin to practice conservation efforts now like farmers and their families. For all of us can intensify the effects from a drought, especially when we are not using water resources effectively and efficiently.

Farmers know the importance of conserving water. They use the "checkbook principle" of irrigation---balancing plant moisture needs with rainfall. We can learn from them by selecting grasses and plants that don't need a lot of water; by watering lawns infrequently, but deeply; by avoiding watering at night which encourage disease; by only applying water as fast as it can be absorbed; and by not over-watering.

I ask you to join me in attempting to ease the burden on our water supplies by practicing proactive conservation. Instead of handling a drought in a reactive manner, following these tips could help us during the heat of the summer when water will be needed.

Although Phil thinks he can predict the weather, he can't tell us what the spring and summer will bring for the farming community. But, it will be a great help to all of us, if we follow the lead of our farmers in conserving our water resources now and in the future.
